Rich in heritage landmarks, ancient buildings and ruins, this ancient city is only two hours away from the center of Kuala Lumpur. Melaka City

Malacca City (also spelled Melaka) is the capital of the coastal state of Malacca, in southwestern Malaysia. According to the Malay Annals, Melaka was named after a tree. Parameswara, a prince from Palembang, was out hunting when he saw a pelanduk (mouse deer) kick one of his hound dogs. Astonished by the encounter, Parameswara thought that the land would be a great place as a new site for his Malay empire.

St. Peter's Church

Year 1710, The St. Peter's Church is a church in Melaka City, It is the oldest functioning Roman Catholic Church in Malaysia.

Sultan's Well, Jalan Puteri Hang Li Poh

The Hang Li Poh's Well, also known as King's Well, is a historical water well in Malacca City. It is the oldest water well in Malaysia. (The locals throw coins in to the well for good luck)

Bukit China (Chinese Hill)

Drive past the largest 15th Century Chinese Cemetery outside of China, located at Bukit China or Chinese Hill. It is also well-known as heritage cemetery

Little India Melaka

Pass by Little India, you can see the heritage building of chettier

Church of St. Francis Xavier

This twin-spired neo-gothic structure was built on the site of an old Portuguese church by a French priest, Father Farvé, in 1856, in honor of St. Francis Xavier, a prominent 16th-century Catholic missionary also known as 'Apostle of the – East.

Pass by

Red Square (Dutch Square)

Red Square – the Salmon – Pink Dutch administrative buildings which today houses the Melaka Museum and some other government offices.

Dutch Square (Red Square)

Head to the center of the World Heritage-listed town to admire the buildings of Windmill at Dutch Square. Constructed between 1660 and 1700, the terracotta buildings showcase colonial Dutch style.

Menara Jam Melaka / Melaka Clock Tower

The Tang Beng Swee Clock Tower outside the Stadthuys was given to the people of Malacca in 1886 by Mr Tan Jiak Kim to fulfil the desires of his father, Tan Beng Swee, who was a third generation of a Chinese philanthropic millionaire family.

Pass by

Queen Victoria's Fountain

Built in 1901 by the British. The Queen Victoria's Fountain is located in the same area as The Stadthuys Malacca and the Christ Church. It is just beside the Tan Beng Siew Clock Tower. The fountain was built to commemorate the Diamond Jubilee of Queen Victoria.

Dutch Square Or Red Square, The Stadthuys

The Stadthuys is a historical structure situated in the heart of Malacca City Malaysia in a place known as the Red Square. The Stadhuys is known for its red exterior and nearby red clocktower. It was built by the Dutch in 1650 as the office of the Dutch Governor and Deputy Governor.

Christ Church

Christ Church Malacca is an 18th-century Anglican church in the city of Malacca City. It is the oldest functioning Protestant church in Malaysia and is within the jurisdiction of the Lower Central Archdeaconry of the Anglican Diocese of West Malaysia.

St. Paul's Hill & Church (Bukit St. Paul)

Saint Paul's Church is a historic church building in Malacca City, Malaysia that was originally built in 1521, making it the oldest church building in Malaysia and Southeast Asia. It is located at the summit of St. Paul's Hill.

Dutch Fort, Bandar Hilir

The site of former Malay sultanates & Portuguese Fort which the local government build Replica on top of the original Dutch Laterite stone.

A Famosa Fort

A Famosa is a former Portuguese fortress located in Malacca. It is among the oldest surviving European architectural remains in Southeast Asia and the Far East. The Porta de Santiago, a small gate house, is the only part of the fortress which still remains today.

Melaka Sultanate Palace Museum

Malacca Sultanate Palace Museum is a museum located in Malacca City. The building is a modern reconstruction of the palace of the Malacca Sultanate.

Maritime Museum is a museum about maritime activities in Malacca City.

Chinatown – Melaka (Jonker Street)

Take a stroll along Melaka's Antique Street which ends by the banks of the Melaka River. Bustling open-air market on weekend nights with an array of food & souvenirs, plus entertainment.

Cheng Hoon Teng Temple

We visit the 'Abode of the Green Merciful Clouds' or the Cheng Hoon Teng Temple – the only temple where you can find 3 major doctrines of local Chinese belief under the same roof, i.e. Taoism, Buddhism, and Confucianism.

Sri Pogyatha Vinoyagar Moorthi Temple

Sri Poyatha Moorthi Temple is the oldest Hindu temple in Malaysia and one of the oldest functioning Hindu temples in Maritime Southeast Asia. The temple is situated on Jalan Tukang Emas, also known as "Harmony Street"

Masjid Tengker

Tranquerah Mosque is a mosque in Malacca City. It was built in 1728

Jonker Street

Free & easy, you have free time to shopping and explore the local food, fruit, cookies, antiques and many more
